



Non fiction (fact) book reading prompts

When you have finished reading a book you could choose a couple of these questions to talk about, to check if your child understood what they read.

- How do you know that this is a non fiction book?
- What is the title of this book? Can you find a sub-title in the book?
- Why did you choose this book to read?
- Which section did you like best? Where can we find that on the contents page?
- Is there a glossary? What can we find there? (*word meanings*)
- What was your favourite fact? What else did you learn?
- How can we find out about.....? (*look at the index*)
- Was there a diagram or table in the book? What did it tell us?
- Which picture or photograph did you like in the book?
- Was there a caption with the picture? What does it say?
- Have you read other books about this topic?
- Would you recommend this book to a friend? Why?
